

Getting to Sorrento by Public Transportation

From Naples Capodichino Airport

Take the **Curreri bus** (6) from the **Capodichino** airport terminal directly to Sorrento.

Buses run frequently in the summer months, and tickets can be purchased on board for EUR 10.

Da Naples Central Train Station

The **Circumvesuviana train** (7) is located on the lower level of the station, where trains depart for **Sorrento**.

The ticket for Sorrento costs EUR 3.60, and trains depart every 20 minutes to make the hour-long trip. Circumvesuviana trains are often crowded and there is no luggage storage area.

From Naples by Ferry

A fun and easy way to reach Sorrento is with the high speed ferry which departs from the Molo Beverello pier and reaches the port of Sorrento in 40 minutes.

The Beverello pier is in **Piazza Municipio**, which can be reached from the airport with the **Alibus bus** (5) (second stop, Piazza Municipio/Molo Beverello) and from the train station with the subway (line 1, Piazza Municipio stop).

The route does not run frequently and high speed ferry routes are suspended in case of rough seas.



For a stress-free arrival, we suggest booking a private transfer.

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
Getting to Grand Hotel Due Golfi from Sorrento:


Once you have reached Sorrento, there are a number of options for getting to Grand Hotel Due Golfi:

- Bus: Sita public buses depart around every 30 minutes from the Sorrento train station, where you will be arriving if you have taken the Circumvesuviana train or the Curreri airport bus from Naples.
- Taxi: there are taxi stands at both the train station and port in Sorrento; the fare for Sant'Agata can be more than EUR 50.
- Shuttle bus: our free shuttle service departs from Piazza Antiche Mura in Sorrento. From the train station, you can reach Piazza Antiche Mura by walking down Via degli Aranci or Corso Italia (about 15 minutes on foot; see the map).

If you are arriving at the port, we recommend taking the public elevator up to the **Villa Comunale** and then walk up **Via Torquato Tasso** and **Via Sersale** (less than 10 minutes on foot).

Shuttle schedule: 9.00 / 10.30 / 12.30 / 17.00 / 19.00 / 21.30 / 23.30





Getting Here by Car

Dalla A3 Napoli-Salerno uscite a Castellammare di Stabia

- Continue straight along the highway SS 145. After a number of scenic twists and turns, you'll arrive at **Meta**, the first town on the Sorrentine Peninsula.
- Pass Meta and turn left after the bridget.
- The road continues uphill to a **church**, where you will **turn right**.
- Continue straight until you reach an intersection. **Highway SS 163** (the famous Amalfi Coast highway) begins in front of you, but you will turn right on **Via Nastro Azzurro**, which leads directly to **Sant'Agata sui Due Golfi**.
- Our hotel is at the entrance to town.

Please Note!

Follow the street directions and map provided **rather than GPS or sat nav devices**, as many choose routes along **difficult country roads best avoided**.

The route on Google Maps is correct.
